Bil 85-026 A Bill to Approve the Amended Budget (2nd ed.)

Abstract:

After an enrollment recount by the Registrar's Office, the number of full time and part time students has changed from what was originally announced after September 20. The updated information shows 489 full-time students and 14 part-time students, creating a budget of \$118,200.

Bill 85-026 amends the budget approved by the Senate on September 8 to reflect the updated enrollment numbers. Adjustments to the budget include:

1. Adjusting stipend pay to reflect the new 17% stipend cap
2. Increased funding to Internal Operations (+\$10), Special Projects (+\$1,930), and the RSO Fund (+\$1,000)

Whereas, the budget of the Student Government Association is completely funded by the Student Government Fee and dependent on the number of student at Bethel College, and

Whereas, the number of students is greater than what the current Fiscal '18 budget is based on.

Therefore, Let it be Enacted: The amended Fiscal '18 Budget reflecting the current and finalized number of students at Bethel College (see Appendix A) be approved by the Senate.
