85-028 *A Bill to Re-design the Student Organization Process*

Abstract: The current process for new student organizations lacks the ability for new student organizations to thoroughly describe their intentions during the application process. To make this process more efficient, the president of the club or some representative of the club shall present to the senate a more detailed description of what their vision for the club would entail.

Whereas, the Bethel College Student Government Association promotes the interest and concerns of the student body in matters that affect the College Community; and,

Whereas, the Bethel College Student Government Association promotes effective use of time and resources, such as the Student Government Fee; and,

Whereas, the current application process for new student organizations lacks thorough description of the hopeful club.

Therefore, Let it be Enacted: upon a successful passage of this bill, the Bethel College Student Government Association will amend governing documents to state the following:

1. Any student organization seeking recognition by the Student Government Association will be required to be present at the SGA Senate meeting that the vote is scheduled to take place
2. The Speaker of the Senate, Chair of the FSO or the Secretary of Student Activities will reach out to the President of record to invite the student to the Senate meeting at least one week before the meeting
3. The SGA Senate cannot consider the vote if a representative from the organization is not present

Be it further Enacted: that the Secretary of Student Activities is authorized to update the RSO Application Form
