87-029: *Stipends when Resigning*

Abstract:

Whenever a member in a paid position of Student Government (including RSOs) resigns without submitting a letter of resignations they will not receive that quarterly stipend. Additionally, if a member in a paid position has an unexcused absence from any of their organizations or committees meetings/events before submitting the letter, they will get paid for the last time they were active in their organization.

Whereas, when a member of student government resigns from a paid position it is their responsibility to submit a formal letter of resignation

Recognizing the importance of submitting this letter as it allows for the Chief of Staff to calculate how much money that individual will get paid based on how much they have worked for the quarter

Recognizing without this formal letter it is unjust to estimate how money a paid member of SGA should receive by guessing what day they have resigned.

Therefore, Let it be Enacted that when a member of a paid position in SGA resigns, they must submit their letter of resignation in order to get paid.
