87-050: A Bill to Permit Talkaphone Committee Spending Privileges during Senate Recess

Abstract:

This bill authorizes the individuals who have been working with Vice President for Student Life, Sam Haynes, on the project to pursue installation of emergency safety stations on campus to spend no more than \$10,000 from SGA's internal operations or special projects funds. This bill gives the committee the ability to make financial decisions on behalf of SGA as a whole during the decision-making process of potentially ordering and installing a Talkaphone Emergency Safety Station tower.

Whereas, Senate will be on recess during the summer months when school is not session,

Understanding, decisions to continue the special project of ordering and installation of Talkaphone Emergency Safety Stations will need to continue into the summer, including some financial decisions,

Acknowledging, that members of the Talkaphone committee include Alayna Wallace, Caroline Preheim, Ahmed Fall, and Naomi Epp.

Respecting, these committee members are responsible and experienced members of SGA who are able to make responsible financial decisions on behalf of the senate and SGA during periods when the senate is on recess,

Therefore, Let it be Enacted: The Talkaphone special project committee is given permission to spend no more than \$10,000 on processes associated with the ordering, installation, and overall processes of the Talkaphone project as the committee sees fit.
