**88-007: *A Bill to Fund the Renovation of the Sand Volleyball Court and Outdoor Basketball Court***

**Abstract:**

This is a bill to allocate funds to the renovation of the sand volleyball court and outdoor basketball court to the north of Voth Hall on Bethel's campus. This area has a great deal of potential for student engagement and experience. This renovation will include improvements to the quality of sand on the volleyball court. Additionally, improvements will be made to the basketball court including painted lines and improved nets and basketball backboards. This bill will allocate \$2000 from the Special Projects fund to the renovation of the sand volleyball court and outdoor basketball court.

**Whereas**, the sand volleyball court and the outdoor basketball court are popular places on campus for student engagement and experience,

**Whereas**, there is a great deal of potential in this space to host SAC events or other campus activities and tournaments,

**Whereas**, many students have asked for improvements to be made to this area of campus,

**Whereas**, Micheal Unruh is allowing this to be a place for Bethel students to volunteer for their annual service work during the Bethel College Service Day 2020,

**Recognizing** that the following improvements will be made to the sand volleyball court with the associated prices listed:

1. Building up the boarder around the outside of the sand court with additional railroad ties: \$400-\$600
2. Rebar to enforce the border and make it safe: \$150-\$225
3. Adding additional sand to the sand volleyball pit: \$300-\$500
4. Tools and chemicals to remove weeds and branches: \$100-\$150

**Recognizing** that the following improvements will be made to the outdoor basketball court with the associated prices listed:

1. Repainting the lines on the court (paint and brushes and tape): \$50-\$100
2. New basketball nets: \$10-\$25
3. Tools and materials to scrape and sand the backboards before repainting: \$100-\$200

**Recognizing** that additional costs may come up during this process and that we have responsible parties including President A. Wallace, VP T. Kucera, and Senator T. Wallace leading this project,

**Recognizing** that due to the decrease in events that SGA can hold this year and at the end of last year, SGA has funds available to improve areas of campus and enhance student experience through the use of our special projects fund,

**Therefore, Let it be Enacted** that \$2000 be allocated to fund the renovation of the sand volleyball court and outdoor basketball court as to be begun on Service Day and completed during the Fall of 2020.
