## **88-008: A Bill to Amend the Laundry Bill**

### **Abstract:**

This is a bill to amend the laundry Bill proposed in the 87th session of the Student Government Association. In order to get higher quality machines that work at higher efficiency and hold a higher capacity of clothes, SGA would need to amend the previous bill. The new plan would be to split the cost of the higher-end laundry machines with the college. The plan is outlined below.

1. Purchase the high-efficiency washers and dryers (\$16,163.00 cost)
2. Start with Haury Hall
3. 3-year project (one hall a year)
4. Future projects funding will be split 50% SGA and 50% Bethel
5. Current year (2020) project funding

Senior class funding	\$5,000 (60% to reduce Bethel share, 40% to reduce SGA)
SGA	\$6,000
Bethel	\$5,000
6. 60% of all fundraised dollars will go to the college while 40% will go to SGA as a gesture of goodwill.

**Whereas,**

Whereas, students have been asking for the addition of Laundry machines on campus for an extremely long time

Whereas with Corona hygiene is more important than ever and having inefficient laundry units could put residents on Bethel College Campus at risk.

Recognizing it will take three years to complete this project

Recognizing that SGA will put forth 50% of the total cost per year (total cost per year equals \$8,081.50) if no money is fundraised.

Recognizing this is a chance to partner with the administration as they would cover 50% of the cost per year.

Therefore, Let it be Enacted: SGA will cover 50% of the funds needed to add laundry units per building for the next three years.
