Whereas, the Bethel College Student Government Association promotes the interest and concerns of the student body in matters that affect the College Community, AND,

Whereas, the Student Government Association is charged with overseeing the distribution and use of monetary funds for all internal purposes, agencies, and registered student organizations utilizing the Student Government Fee collected each semester, AND,

Recognizing, the Student Government Association has projected a budget of \$93,900 Fiscal 21 Year as set by Bethel College Administration projection of full-time students, AND,

Whereas, the Student Government Association is charged with utilizing their budget efficiently, effectively, and with future Student Government Associations in mind, AND

Whereas, the Committee on Finance and Student Organizations, Chief of Staff and the SGA Advisor met to hold Budget Hearings with the various entities regarding their budget requests for the Fiscal 21 year, AND,

Whereas, after the Budget Hearings, the Committee and others voted unanimously to submit the following Budget Proposal forward to the full Senate for approval, AND

Whereas, stipend limits, as specified in the Full SGA Fiscal '20 Budget Proposal, are a part of the Budget Proposal and, if approved, are constitutionally binding,

Therefore, Let it be Enacted: that upon approval of this bill by the SGA Senate and the Student Body President, the Fiscal 2021 Budget for the Student Government Association shall be approved and fully enacted by the 88th SGA Chief of Staff.
